

1 is \$186,356; and then the present value of the
2 household services is \$39,256.

3 And then we could add these two together for
4 the total, which, in this particular case is, again,
5 12, 11; so, in this particular case, it would be
6 \$225,612.

7 Q And that final figure you have provided us,
8 is that, again, a figure to a reasonable degree of
9 economic certainty?

10 A Yes.

11 Q And the discount rate that you utilized, was
12 it not considered at the time you generated your
13 report for us in this case, and I believe that was
14 January of 1996?

15 A That is correct.

16 Q Is the discount rate today the same as it
17 was then?

18 A The discount rate today is a little higher.

19 Q Okay. What would that do to the final
20 figure?

21 A It would lower it slightly.
