8 Q And have you actually used sampling devices
9 at different locations?

10 A Yes.

11 Q So are you familiar with the different types
12 and the history of the different types of devices that
13 have been used?

14 A Yes, as part of my work, yes.

15 Q And have you actually as a further part of
16 your work and as a result of those field visits
17 actually looked at your asbestos and asbestos fibers
18 under the microscope?

19 A Yes. In 1971 when I worked with NIOSH, I
