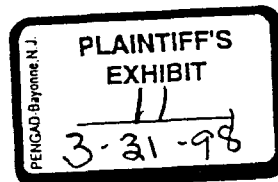

These fish were sampled in the following manner: fillets were removed from both sides of each fish and passed through a meat grinder until a homogenous tissue mass was obtained. A 50g portion of the tissue homogenate was then extracted, worked up, and analyzed in accordance with Analytical Method 70-1. All calculations were made on the basis of total peak area in the chromatographic elution region of interest. DDE was observed in samples 403-407. The results reported were corrected for DDE by subtracting the area for this peak from the total area.
