2 A That is right.

3 Q That individual had died from asbestosis?

4 A Yes, indeed.

5 Q So we know in 1996 it could be fatal, and we
6 knew that back in 1930, too, didn't we?

7 A Yes.

8 Q So all of the things that we know today
9 about asbestosis we knew back in 1930. There is no
10 dispute about that, do you agree with me?

11 A Not all of the things we know today, but
12 many of the things we know today, that is correct.

13 Q I am not talking about all of them.

14 A You said all.

15 Q All of these things that you have on the
16 board, asbestos --

17 A All of the things on the board were known
18 then and are known now, that is correct.

19 Q In fact, you would agree with me, wouldn't
20 you, Doctor, that all of those things make asbestosis
21 such a hazardous disease that you would agree with me
