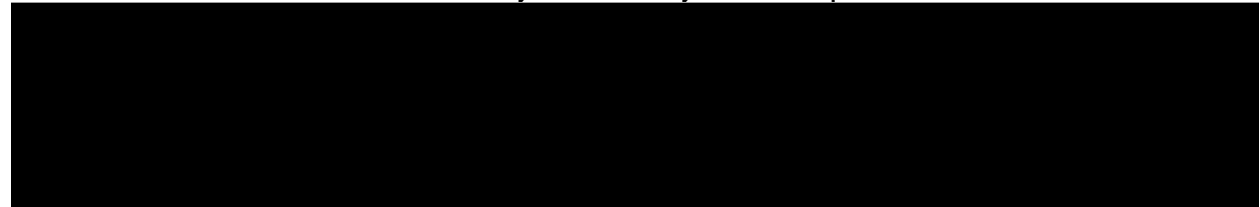

RE: Letter to President Trump Dated April 25, 2017 Regarding Saving the United States Coal Industry & Making NASA Great Again!

Dear Vice-President Pence:

Several weeks have passed since I first contacted The White House regarding saving the United States Coal Industry. RE: Saving the United States Coal Industry

Dear Mr. President:

First, let me say how proud I am of you for sticking to your promises, executing your robust daily schedule and maintaining a penchant for straight talk. As a Veteran, concerned US Citizen and Father, I am happier every day that I voted for you. This isn't something that I have felt since I voted for Ronald Reagan.
