My dear Warren:-

Referring to your favor of Nov. 28th ,
I recently received by freight the Pure Prepared and Phoenix
books. Took up the matter with Whitehead & Hoag Co.
They quote as follows:--

"Referring to the lithographic prints, submitted
to the writer several days ago for quotations on same made up
into Crystaloid signs with easel stand and cord hanger, beg to
say we can make up the oval prints into a 10 X 14 sign, at
21¢ each in any quantity. Should you desire them without the
easels the deduction would be at the rate of \$15.00 per 1000.

The rectangular shaped pictures, we can make up
for you in any quantity at 15¢ each, including easel back and
cord hanger. Deduction without the easels \$8.00 per 1000.
These prices are f.o.b. Newark, less 1% 10 days or 30 days net.

Should you favor us with an order, would request
that you use every effort to have the prints as large as
possible so that we would have plenty of room for turning over
