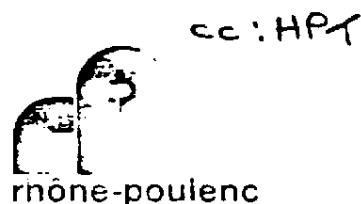

Dear Ralph,

The lecture of your letter was very comforting, as I've been so sorry to miss the Toxicology Committee Meeting. Would it be possible to receive the minutes if they are published? Organisational matter often becomes more important than the real problems we have to cope with.

Following your recommendation I called Peter Claus, who immediately convened me at the 8 and 9 October joint meeting.

In the course of a telephone conversation yesterday, Professor MALTONI, told me that he will teach at Mount Sinai Medical School from 18 June to 29 June, and would like very much "to meet someone from S.P.I.". MALTONI apparently is prepared to give you some information on styrene he was not able to tell last year when asked by your collaborators.

We are still waiting for the final statement on the vinyl chloride study. Our statisticians collaborate with MALTONI in order to give a mathematical support to his conclusions.

If we hold the present schedule, oral and written presentation should take place in October!

Looking forward to meet you in DUSSELDORF, and why not in PARIS if you have the possibility to visit us, I wish you all the best.
