RE: Victopac Production Transition

Many thanks for your note of February 19, setting forth the ground rules involving the above transition as it relates to materials.

My staff has been instructed to and are already involved in phase-outs of all materials that relate to Victopac. By the time the phase-out is completed, (other than asbestos fibre) we should have only a negligible amount of constituents remaining which will be resold to our regular sources. The only item we intend to resell to you would be asbestos fibre.

We intend to maintain minimum inventories on this material to the point where we hope to have only a small quantity available for sale to you. I suggest you keep yourself protected material wise - our present well organized and disciplined materials management will not place you in a position to rely on us for availability of excess or surplus constituents.
