  - (d) L.I.A. Project 27, To Test Various Wash Primers and Anticorrosive Primers in Seawater, Total Immersion and Tide Range, and Fresh Water. (Two year inspection report will be submitted at meeting. Details of project attached as Exhibit "C" of minutes of May 8 and 9, 1958, meeting.)
