We do not have the faintest idea of the potential demand for this product. We believe that the General Sales should be in better position to supply this information than anyone else.

In Mr. Watt's bulletin the statement is made the "present plans are for each plant to stock raw materials necessary to make 20 tons of Acoustical Plaster" and that Mr. Grieve or Mr. Trelley should advise what quantities should be ordered.

Formula for Acoustical Plaster is as follows:

Bentonite Clay	300 lbs.
7D Asbestos	572 "
Perlite	1,120 "
Tetre Sodium Pyro	
Phosphate	3 "
Ultra Wet DS	5 "
	<u>2,000</u> "

We have the Ultra Wet DS and the perlite. We believe it would be wiser to buy the other raw materials in small lots until some idea can be obtained of the demand for acoustical plaster than to buy in truck lots with the possibility of having to charge off considerable quantities.

Will you please check with Mr. Grieve and with General Sales and order
