The Office of Industrial Relations of the Navy disseminates to all shore activities of the Navy and Marine Corps accident analyses and educational material in the form of magazines, books, posters, bulletins, and films. It also issues the following manuals: *Application of Color to the Shore Establishment*, *Motor Vehicle Accident Prevention Manual*, and *U S Navy Manual of Safety Equipment*.

The monthly magazine, *Safety Review*, is available on a single copy or subscription basis. The manual, *U S Navy Safety Precautions* (1953) with five up-dating changes, may also be obtained by private companies or individuals. Both releases are sold by the Superintendent of Documents, Washington, D C.

The Navy has also produced the following safety films: *To Live in Darkness*, *Safety in Offices*, and *Safety in Air Stations*, available for rent or purchase from a commercial distributor.
