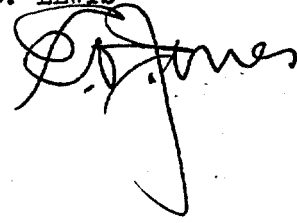

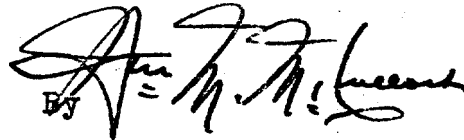
Gentlemen:
