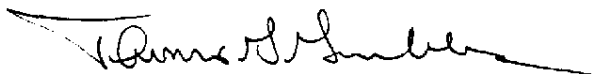

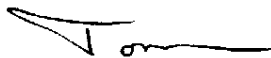
SUBJ: DOT HAZARDOUS MATERIALS REGULATIONS TRAINING

Included in the registration fee are two coffee breaks and a luncheon. The registration fee is \$55 for HMAC members, state and local government officials, and \$75 for all others. A \$10 charge will be added to the advance fee for pay-at-the-door registrants IF space is available. Registration begins at 8:00 A.M.
