On behalf of the European Semiconductor Industry association (ESIA) I would like to ask you the following:

In the context of the upcoming ESIA members' meeting on 21 September in the morning, I would kindly ask if ESIA could have a presentation from you or a colleague on the ongoing PFAS restriction process.

ESIA would hope for a presentation of about 20 minutes – followed by a Q&A session with members for another 20-25 min.
