RE: SHIPMENTS OUT OF ACME

J-M still continues to send trucks with no tarpaulins and no provisions for tie-down of loads to the Acme Plant for gypsum shipment.

I still think this is dangerous and that it can hit back at Bestwall's arrangements with Bestwall's trucker.

We've talked about this many times, but J-M continued to procrastinate. I still think and recommend again that we tell J-M that after a certain date the Acme Plant will not load a truck which does not have certain minimum requirements which include tarpaulins and provisions for tying down the load and, furthermore, that the Acme Plant personnel will do neither. This matter has been discussed since last September with the continual promise by J-M people that they are "gonna" get some proper equipment. A shipment as of 3-24-64 was made with Acme providing a visqueen cover over the truck and material to tie-down the order, as well as doing the actual work.

They can always get their truck shipments on the same trucks furnishing Bestwall service.
