Attached is the listing of those employees monitored for VCM exposure during the month of September, 1984.

Five of the thirty-five employees monitored revealed 8-hr. TWA's above the PEL.

Dispersion Foreman, 9/21/84: #1 BT foamed out at the exhaust port. The employee was in the area during the TEST run of the new liquid screener. No M.T.

Tower Operator, 9/6/84: Leak on emulsifier scale. #2 filter open, exhaust not working. Leak in SO valve in penthouse. No M.T.

GSO, Reactor Cleaner, 9/14/84: Bird watching R-7. No M.T.

Reactor Operator, Dump, 9/13/84: Leak from F-101 drifted to BT's. Inspected chip basket during batch transfer. 10 minutes M.T.

Maintenance Mech., 9/6/84: Repaired leaky union on "A" emulsifier scale. No M.T.

Two area samples were taken in the Suspension Plant construction area. The samples were taken at the S-4 on the first and second floor. Both samples showed a 8-hr. TWA of 0.1ppm, VCM.
