WAS DUE TO MUCH REDUCED ACTIVITY IN THIS
PRODUCT LINE DURING THAT PERIOD. IT APPEARS
THAT OUR BUSINESS ACTIVITY HAS IMPROVED AND
WE ANTICIPATE OUR PROCESS WASTE TO BE
UP SUBSTANTIALLY.
