Subpoena For Records
vs. Celotex, et al.

Per our recent phone conversation, I am attaching copies of documents provided to our Workers' Compensation service company regarding the Workers' Comp claim filed by our employee,

who has since died and his widow is filing a suit against the manufacturer of asbestos-containing products sold to Sherwin-Williams. A copy of the subpoena for our records is also attached for your review.

Unfortunately, purchase orders or copies of contracts with building contractors are not kept longer than five years. As you can see from our "Specification of Purchased Material" that Witco Chemical Company was a supplier for our Asphalt Base in the late '60's and early '70's.

I understand that the contractor for the construction work done in the Paint Department in 1964 was Fred Berglund & Sons (a Chicago based company) and that they used a subcontractor for insulating the process equipment and piping. We have no record of the insulation product manufacturer or the installer. This insulation was used in compliance with Chicago building codes.
