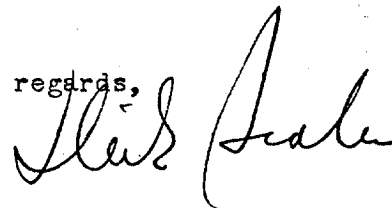
Dear Bob:

Attached is a copy of a letter we received here at the laboratory from Mr. C. E. Frudden, Consulting Engineer of the Tractor Division of the Allis-Chalmers Manufacturing Company.
