Recently we were visited by Dr. I. C. Riggin, Health Commissioner of Lorain City and Dr. H. Robert Coler of the Health Department of the State of Ohio. They came to investigate our atmospheric condition because of the report as submitted by Mr. Jack Wunderle, District Industrial Hygiene Engineer. We are inclosing a copy of Mr. Wunderle's report for your examination. We explained to the two doctors that we had contacted your Laboratory and that an investigation was made even prior to Mr. Wunderle's visit. Inasmuch as the subject of atmospheric lead is such a complicated one and so diverse, I would appreciate it very much if you would contact both Dr. I. C. At the present we are examining Mr. Roberts' recommendations relative to our melting room and are planning to talk with Mr. Wunderle about them. Since delivery dates are so long on the equipment needed, we are planning on taking immediate action on Mr. Roberts' recommendations.
