

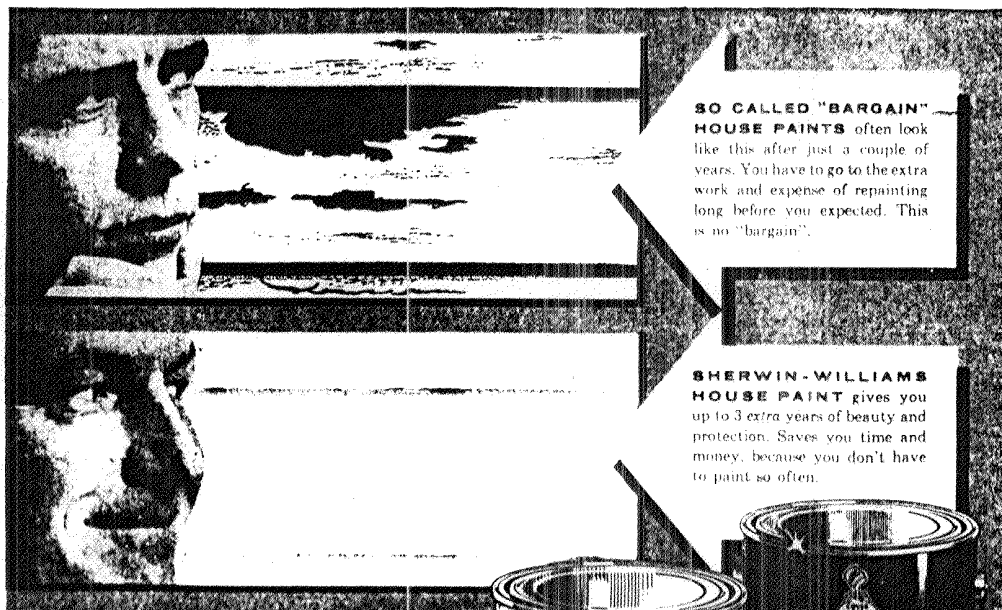

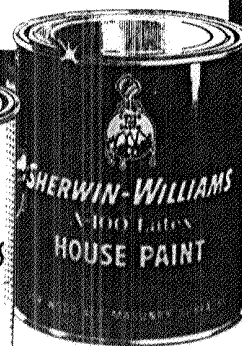
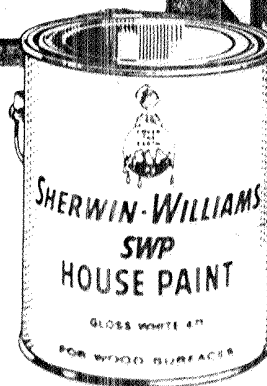

New Dem In the Sena

Sacramento

Democratic ranks in the
Legislature were further
split yesterday over the ri-
val senatorial candidacies
of State Controller Alvin
Cranston and Pierre Salin-
ger.

Assemblyman Gordon Win-
ton of Merced lambasted
Speaker Jesse M. Unruh of
Los Angeles for his charge
that the State inheritance tax
appraisers constitute "the
most single corrupting in-
fluence in California" politi-
cally.

The appraisers are ap-
pointed by the controller.
Winton is backing Cranston
over Salinger.

SUPPORT

Meanwhile, Assemblyman
Leo J. Ryan of South San
Francisco announced his sup-
port for Salinger and as-
sailed Cranston for the con-
troller's recent attack on Un-
ruh. Ryan said the attack "is
a disservice to the party,"
and declared it "has left me
no alternative" but to sup-
port Salinger.

Winton, who opposed Un-
ruh for the speakership and
Unruh's attack on the tax
inheritance appraisers, said
he was "abashed and exasperated."

Unruh's attack on the ap-
