Action on PFAS under other EU legislation

- **F-Gas Regulation**

- Primary focus to reduce climate impact of F-gases, BUT many F-gases are PFAS as they degrade to TFA
- Will apply as from around March 2024, to be reviewed in 2030
- Includes measures to
 - **Prevent emissions** from uses, products and equipments
 - **Reduce F-gas supply** to the market (HFC quota systems and F-gas prohibition on placing on the market)
- Prohibitions on placing on the market that de facto will ban PFAS F-gases (examples):
 - Domestic refrigerators and freezers (2026)
 - Small AC/heat pumps: 2032 or 2035
 - Insulation foams: 2033
