As you doubtless know, Mr. Simpson of Raybestos-Manhattan has also written to me on this subject and I am therefore sending him a copy of this letter. The enclosed copy of a recent letter from Dr. Peter W. Edwards, one of Dr. Gardner's British colleagues, is of at least passing interest in this connection.
