RE: Refined Asbestos Contract
Bishop, Texas Plant

Gentlemen:

The referenced contract existing between us dated November 1, 1976 as variously amended and extended, will expire on December 31, 1984.

We hereby propose to extend the term of said contract for another year through December 31, 1985. All the terms and conditions thereof as amended shall remain unchanged and of the same force and effect except as the same shall be further amended in the following respects:

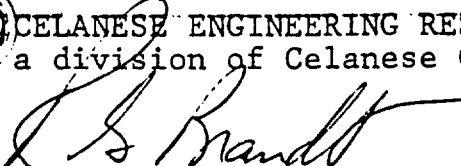
1. QUANTITY shall be a minimum of 120,000 pounds and a maximum of 225,000 pounds.
2. PRICE in cents per pound for 35 pound bags in shrink-wrapped pallet loads shall be .50 cents for truckload shipments (17 pallets). There will be no additional charge for shrink-wrap. The price shall be F.O.B. shipping point, King City, CA.
3. Operation of that portion of Paragraph 1 of the Terms and Conditions which provides for price changes shall remain suspended during 1985, i.e., price for truckload quantities shall not be subject to increase by Seller during 1985.

Your proposal is to be competitive, taking into account the need to maintain raw material price stability throughout the year.

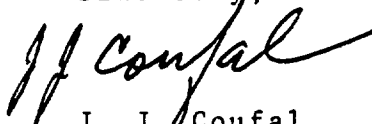
Please quote best firm price, terms, FOB our Bishop Plant for the following volume: 120M - 225M lbs.
