Dear Manfred:

With further reference to your letter of February 1 to Dr. McCabe, while I was in Los Angeles I found that there was nothing new regarding the lead "claims." I discussed the matter quite thoroughly with Mr. Griswold, and he believes that, at least for the time being, his letter to Mrs. Palfreyman appears to have had a quieting effect. However, as you are aware, these people are not inclined to accept refutation to their claims even though the latter are without documented support. Therefore, it might be well to consider additional survey work specifically aimed at lead concentrations in the atmosphere.

We have established several "outposts" in Los Angeles, so if I hear of anything new, I will let you know at once.

Both Dr. McCabe and I are most appreciative of the friendly wishes expressed in your letter of January 11.
