Telephone call December 15, 1938.

Concerning one [REDACTED] employee or customer of Ohio Oil Company who, according to information from Mr. McCammon of Ohio Oil, Tulsa, was injured when siphoning leaded gasoline from a barrel.

Now in hospital in Pryor, Oklahoma, under care of Dr. Van Dolph Herrington, with swollen face and neck. To telephone Dr. Herrington and notify Dees of situation for information of McCammon.

Telephoned Dr. Herrington, who said the sick man had a cervical adenitis which was in no way attributable to gasoline or lead. Discussed briefly the symptoms and toxic effect likely to follow ingestion of gasoline, which were not present, according to Dr. Herrington, in this case.

Notified Dees by wire of outcome.
