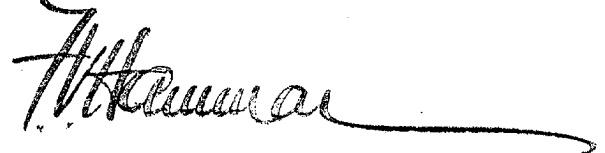
My dear Dr. Edsall:
