Examination of the chest (stereo)

There is a large amount of light fluffy deposit starting in both hilar regions and extending out to the periphery. The apices are relatively clear but otherwise the involvement is fairly general. The diaphragm is very much elevated on the right. The aorta shows a considerable enlargement and the trachea is displaced to the right.
