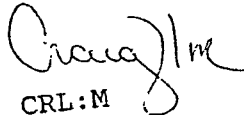

Subject: Medical Surveillance - Asbestos Related Referrals

Any medical referral that is asbestos disease related from our medical surveillance program must have their medical histories, x-rays and work history sent to Dr. Paul Wheeler of John Hopkins University Hospital. Dr. Wheeler is recognized as a leading authority of x-ray interpretation regarding asbestosis related disease and as such will be considered our diagnostic expert in this area.

The cost for this diagnostic expertise is \$400/hour and will be borne by the plant medical programs. It is critical that the foremost authority on x-ray interpretation is used in order to assure that the medical opinion is above reproach.

Please advise Division of any referrals so that the proper arrangements can be made with Dr. Wheeler.
