

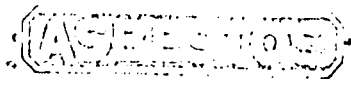

Dear Sirs:

I thought you might be interested in knowing that starting this week, shipments of this Company's asbestos to Canadian and American customers only will bear the following notice in English printed on each bag:

CAUTION

"This bag contains chrysotile asbestos fibre.
Persons exposed to this material should use
adequate protective devices as inhalation of
this material over long periods may be harmful."

Although this practice is being initiated now, it will be some months before all shipments to the North American market will be so marked pending the disposal of inventories.
