Dear Bill:

As a matter of interest and in case you were not aware, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has promulgated a final test rule on Bisphenol-A under Section 4 of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA). See 21 C.F.R. §799.940; 51 Fed. Reg. 33047 (Sept. 18, 1986). This rule requires that manufacturers and processors of Bisphenol-A conduct a 90 day subchronic inhalation toxicity test. The Society of the Plastics Industry, Inc. (SPI) has established a task force on BPA to coordinate compliance.
