We were horrified to hear of the death of Drew Wynne, caused by Methylene Chloride. This chemical is available for purchase at Home Depot, Lowe's and hardware stores throughout the country in a product used for stripping floors. The product is called Goof Off. This 31 year old young man followed safety directions religiously with mask and ventilation. It killed him, all the same. How is this product available for purchase? Where is the EPA? THE EPA HAS DELAYED ACTING ON A BAN OF METHYLENE CHLORIDE! This delay is directly responsible for Drew's death, as his autopsy showed.

We learned of this through good friends of Drew's parents, who, as good friends of ours, asked us to communicate our concern with you.

Please address this ban immediately before anyone else is killed. That the EPA has delayed action on this substance is not acceptable. It has been banned by the U.S. Military and the European Union since 2013! What is the point of EPA if not to protect us from this very tragedy?
