Questions: Did Mr. Pruitt in fact tell Ms. Hart that she could talk to Mr. Jackson about finding Mr. Guiliano a job at EPA? What happened? Did Mr. Jackson meet with Mr. Guiliano? Did Mr. Jackson assist Mr. Guiliano in finding an EPA position? Was Mr. Guiliano hired?

"The Agency accepts career recommendations from a number of acquaintances. Ultimately, Mr. Guiliano was not hired."

On October 8, 2017, Mr. Hart emailed Mr. Jackson inviting him to a last-minute dinner at The Rex, a restaurant and bar in Alexandria, Va.. The nature of the exchange -- talk of being a secret liberal, smoking cigars together -- seems to suggest a close personal relationship between Mr. Jackson and Mr. Hart.

Questions: Did Mr. Jackson tell Mr. Hart to push Senator Burr on this nomination? Was that interaction appropriate, given Mr. Pruitt's history with the Harts?

"Ryan Jackson and Mr. Hart are both from Oklahoma and have known each other for years and likely Mr. Hart was still trying to convince Mr. Jackson to convert from being a liberal."

Questions: Are you able to tell us the identities of the candidates Mr. Hart put forward? Were these candidates taken into consideration by the EPA, as Mr. Hart requested?

"Ryan Jackson frequently receives unsolicited emails and these candidates were not considered. Because their names are redacted, they were not selected."

Question: Did Mr. Jackson or others at the EPA engage further with Mr. Hart or Coca Cola on HFCs?

"No."

Question: Was Mr. Moore hired at EPA?

"No."

Important overall questions: The EPA has previously said that there was no lobbying by Mr. Hart of the EPA under Mr. Pruitt. Does the EPA still stand by that assertion? Was Ryan Jackson forthcoming about his interaction with Mr. Hart?

"Yes. Many of these emails were unsolicited and did not impact any Agency policy outcomes."
