I attach herewith original invoice No. A.B.A.-116 dated December 30, 1948 covering 1150 bags of the above fibre, 49.7785 short tons (2,000 lbs.). Price £75-0-0 per 2,000 lbs. f.o.b. steamship Fremantle, Australia. Total cost of the fibre £3733-7-9 plus prepaid ocean freight £241-16-9 plus U. S. Consul's fee £0-15-10. Total amount of invoice in Australian Pounds £3976-0-4. (Conversion rate at \$3.2377 equals \$12,873.1493). The price and extensions both are correct.

This invoice is approved for payment sight draft against bill of lading.

Included in the above shipment were 53 drums of Mine Asbestos Ore, weight approximately 20 tons, on which we have received an invoice marked "no commercial value - no charge". This is invoice A.B.A.-117 dated December 30, 1948, and we are retaining the memorandum invoice in our files.

The 1150 bags of Asbestos Fibre should be charged to Industrial Products Division, Manville factory, and the Mine Asbestos Ore is going to Research Centre, attention of M. S. Badollet.
