This is in answer to your letter of November 8, 1966.

1. ASBESTOSIS

- A. We have no full time insulators on our Plant.
- B. No employees do part time insulating.
- C. The only insulating we would do would be in connection with plant maintenance. This would involve the removal and replacement of asbestos insulation from steam pipes.
- D. We are not doing any spraying of insulating materials here.
- E. We have no known cases of Asbestosis, mesothelioma or carcinomas among insulators.
- F. We have used no preventive measures or safety equipment in the removal and replacement of asbestos insulation (from steam pipes.).
