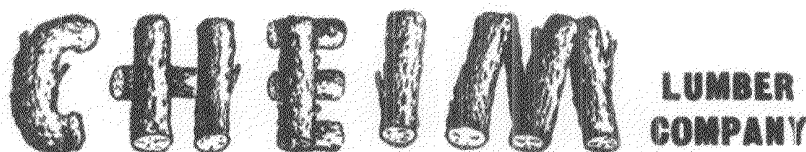

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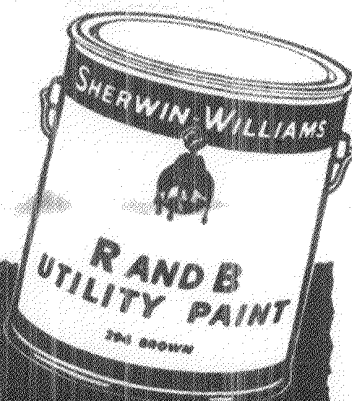
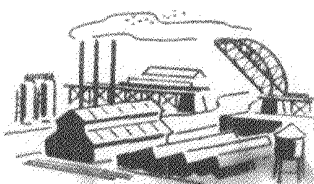


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am I making?" You see, she had just told me she was separating from her husband and on her way to her mother.

Walnut Co-Op Makes Big Cull Payment

Grower-members of the California Walnut Growers Association are currently receiving a salvage return of nearly 1½ million dollars from their cull walnuts, which comprised 14% of the 1951 crop, it was announced by Association General Manager W. C. Tesche.

Eleven thousand members of the state-wide co-operative marketing organization will share in this payment.

Cull walnuts are removed during processing and are unsuitable for in-shell sale because of shell blemishes or partially imperfect kernels. They are cracked, and the edible kernels sold as shelled walnuts. The shells and inedible kernels are used for industrial by-products.

With this cull settlement, grower-members of the Association will have received to date nearly 21½ million dollars for their 1951 walnut crop, with a substantial final payment still to be made in late Summer.

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
