Dear Mr. Taylor:

I wish to quote in substance a report from our Manager at
Barnesboro, Penna. regarding one of our dealer accounts as
follows:

"Mr. [REDACTED] of Mahaffey fell over while at work in his
garage the other day, later he reported to his local doctor
and the doctor advised him that it was a heart condition and
that it was the result of lead poisoning. The doctor stated
that the lead entered his body through his nose, ears, eyes,
etc. and that it was affecting his heart beats." This

Kuntz that he use clear gasoline for cleaning parts, which
more or less indicated that this garage man has been using
leaded gasoline for cleaning parts, which of course is out
