Limited, Canada Metal Company Limited and The Carter
White Lead Company of Canada Limited

Dear Claude:

I have received from Carleton Smith a copy of what is apparently an executed copy of the above-identified agreement.

The agreement is dated as of the thirty-first day of August, 1949; it was executed on behalf of The Sherwin-Williams Company by a Mr. Whittaker; on behalf of Canada Metal Company by J. A. Taylor, and on behalf of The Carter White Lead Company by J. S. (?) Moffat. It provides, inter alia, that Carter White Lead Company has the right to make, use and sell 45X pigment in Canada.

Incidentally, the Canadian patent covering 45X pigment is No. 491,507, title to which is held by the Canada Metal Company. It expires March 24, 1970.

I have a Thermofax copy of the agreement should you care to peruse it.
