I have received copies of your correspondence concerning a letter you received from Steven Dexter of St. Louis dated October 21, 1975.

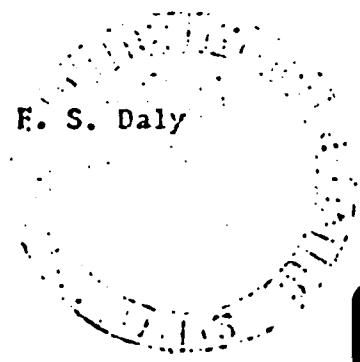
We appreciate the fact that you have notified us of this correspondence for several reasons:

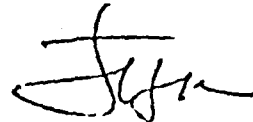
