

1 A Yes.

2 Q Now, when you removed the brakes, did you
3 have to cut the brake pad lining itself or did you
4 just -- you mentioned that you knocked off rivets, but
5 I wasn't real clear about what else you would have to
6 do.

7 A That was years ago. That was back in the
8 '60s. Bendix shoes we did not do that to, no.

9 Q How did you remove them then? Can you
10 describe the procedure for me?

11 A Usually they would be bonded lining already;
12 the Bendix would already be riveted.

13 We sent them out and had them
14 remanufactured, and they would just rivet the new
15 lining to the shoe part.

16 Q So you did not for the Bendix brakes have to
17 remove the riveting, take the riveting off and put on
18 the new lining?

19 A No.

20 Q Now, you mentioned that when you removed the
21 brakes early on in, I guess, the 1950s -- maybe you
