I am dealing with an issue for our client, CVS, and I was hoping you might be willing/available to meet and brainstorm potential solutions. The specific issue involves some confusion over the older, existing effluent guidelines for the pharma manufacturing category (40 CFR Part 439), which we think can be resolved with some simple, clarifying guidance.
