Concerning the Dye loss in the Manufacturing Profit column, this is occasioned by a charge to Plant Alteration & Construction Account of \$12,471 of which the largest item for \$10,554 is for Overages and removal of equipment in Building #303 - Mono Acid Department.

In the Chicago Tin Can, item-Manufacturing column, the majority of the loss of \$1,952.43 for the month is occasioned by the settlement of an Accident case which cost us \$1,042.
