The suddenness of the corporate requirements to formulate all interior-use coatings down to 0.06% Lead, and the immediate need to control production of such items with 0.5% Lead, necessitates immediate transmittal of data on these items to both producing plants and to local service laboratories. The information will be released periodically regarding the status of all formulae in respect to Lead content, heavy metals and Rule 66. The immediate emphasis is on Lead with special emphasis on Ken Lustral since it represents approximately one and one-half million gallons per year.

All rexes will be classified into three major divisions in respect to Lead and the presence of heavy metals beyond 0.05% will be noted when present, otherwise it can be assumed that there is compliance in this area. Since we will also be bringing additional formulae into Rule 66 compliance, this data will also be included in these communications. These divisions are identified as X, V & Z marking to be in the old BSMS position on formula cards.

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1. KEM LUSTRAL

All 34 rexes meet Rule 66.

Our concern not only is to meet cut-off dates at Chicago for sale of coatings with over 0.5% by July 1, 1972, with the national cut-off date 12/31/72, but with the sale of goods using our coatings after 12/31/72. Many manufacturers are requesting certifications down to 0.06% immediately.

Only 12 formulas are below 0.5% Lead, but all are over 0.06% due to drier.

We intend to reformulate all rexes down to 0.06% as quickly as possible. The priority between now and July 1st., will be for those rexes which are presently over 0.5%.

2. SUPER FAST DRI ENAMEL

Not as urgent as Kem Lustral because not normally sold for direct use in the home.

3. RED PRODUCTION ENAMEL, F75 R 2

We are considering this product as exterior non-household general industrial use and presently exempt from the 0.5% Lead requirement.

4. Al8 TRADE SALES OIL STAINS

Per John Piel's March 7th., letter, this entire line has been revised down to the 0.06% Lead maximum guideline.

5. Al8 WATER REDUCIBLE STAINS

New line. Martin-Sancour to produce.

As changes occur in the other lines moving them over to 0.06% Lead where possible, we will include the I, V, or Z on the new formula cards in the BSMS position and will also advise card number and date by direct mail to minimize production on higher Lead formulas. As soon as formulae revisions go thru, each producing plant can immediately put prior cards and matte foils in hold pending arrival of new low lead formula.
