

worn when woodworking or cutting tools, such as chisels, brace and bits, planes, scrapers, and saws, are used head-high or overhead, with the chance of particles falling or flying into the eyes

Occasionally, the need for eye protection is overlooked on such jobs as cutting wire and

cable, striking wrenches, using hand drills, chipping concrete, removing nails from scrap lumber, shoveling material head-high or working on the leeward side of a job, and using wrenches and hammers overhead, and on other jobs where particles of materials or debris may fall

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
