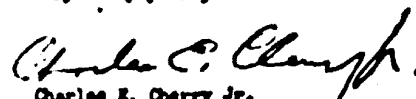
SUBJECT: L.I.A. PROJECT 22

To Members of the Red Lead Technical Committee:

In regard to L.I.A. Project No. 22 (red lead formulations with litharge added in varying amounts) we are informed that after approximately six months' exposure, none of the new galvanized panels shows any failure. It appears, therefore, that we should be able to issue a new Red Lead Technical Letter on the basis of this performance. We wish, therefore, to hold a meeting of the Red Lead Technical Committee for this purpose on Wednesday, January 4, or Thursday, January 5. If neither of these dates is suitable to you, would you please suggest early dates that are?

In reference to the minutes of the Red Lead Technical Committee meeting of November 17, 1955, please note that the angle irons to be exposed at Perth Amboy, N. J. for L.I.A. Project No. 23 should be duplicate mill scaled and single sandblasted rather than one mill-scaled, one rusty, and one sandblasted angle as the minutes state.
