SUBJECT: WEEKLY PROGRESS REPORT

1. CONTINUED TO WORK ON THE VCM LEAK SURVEY. THE LEAK CURVEY IS PROGRESSING ON SCHEDULE. THE ACTUAL SURVEY SHOULD BE COMPLETED NEXT WEEK. OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE, AND PROCESS ENGINEERING ARE CONTINUING TO COORDINATE EFFORTS TO REPAIR THE LEAKS THAT ARE FOUND.
2. RAN ECONOMICS FOR THE RECOVERY SYSTEM REVISIONS PROJECT. THE ECONOMICS ARE TO BE INCLUDED WITH THE PROJECT AFE REQUEST.
3. ATTENDED THE MEETING WITH JOHN PINKMAN FROM CONOCO AND JOE REILLY FROM INDUSTRIAL HANDLING ENGINEERS. JOE REILLY IS A CONSULTANT WHO WILL BE WORKING TO TRY TO IMPROVE THE EFFICIENCY AND REDUCE COSTS IN OUR PACKAGING, WAREHOUSING, AND HANDLING OF THE PVC AND PVC COMPOUNDS AT OUR PLANT.
4. WORKED WITH FRANK CASRE FROM COMBUSTION AND CONTROLS OF MEMPHIS TO REPLACE THE DIGITAL DISPLAY ON THE ZONE 4 TEMPERATURE CONTROLLER ON LINE 1.
5. STARTED LOOKING AT THE PROBLEM OF ORANGE "SPES" IN THE PVC RESIN. AT THE PRESENT TIME I AM LOOKING AT THE FOLLOWING: (1) PROPER RINSE IN THE REACTOR, AND (2) FILTERING THE CHEM WASH TO THE REACTOR.
