I'll see you in Billings for the Roundtable later this afternoon. Just so you're aware, Montana does not have a self-audit law or program for air emissions from oil & gas facilities. We do have a registration program for these facilities, as opposed to an individual permit framework. We also do compliance assistance with our IR camera to identify fugitive emissions.
