PARSONS-SPENCER, INC.
(Herein called the Employer)

is hereby amended as follows:

I. Effective June 22, 1944 as to all Employees of the United States Asbestos Division of the Employer, by adding to the FORMULA which appears on Page 2 of said Group Policy, as amended, the following:

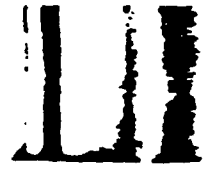
"All Employees who are actively at work on June 22, 1944 and all Employees employed subsequent to June 22, 1944 shall be excluded from eligibility for insurance hereunder, and the insurance hereunder, if any, on all such Employees shall be automatically discontinued on June 22, 1944. Any Employee who is not actively at work on June 22, 1944 shall be excluded from eligibility for insurance hereunder, and his insurance hereunder, if any, shall be automatically discontinued on the thirtieth day following the date of his return to active work, provided he is actively at work on the next succeeding day; if not then actively at work, he shall be excluded from eligibility for insurance hereunder, and his insurance hereunder, if any, shall be automatically discontinued on the day immediately preceding the date of his subsequent return to active work."

II. Effective July 6, 1944 as to Employees of the General Asbestos and Rubber Division of the Employer, by adding to said FORMULA, as amended, the following:

"All Employees who are actively at work on July 7, 1944 and all Employees employed subsequent to July 7, 1944 shall be excluded from eligibility for insurance hereunder, and the insurance hereunder, if any, on all such Employees shall be automatically discontinued on July 6, 1944. Any Employee who is not actively at work on July 7, 1944 shall be excluded from eligibility for insurance hereunder, and the insurance hereunder, if any, shall be automatically discontinued on the thirtieth day following the date of his return to active work, provided he is actively at work on the next succeeding day; if not then actively at work, he shall be excluded from eligibility for insurance hereunder, and his insurance hereunder, if any, shall be automatically discontinued on the day immediately preceding the date of his subsequent return to active work."

III. Effective June 23, 1944 as to Employees of The Canadian Parsonage Company, Limited, and effective on the day immediately following the date of exclusion from eligibility for insurance under said Group Policy in accordance with Parts I and II of this amendment as to all other Employees, (1) by substituting for the word "EMPLOYEES" which appears in the sentence under the heading DEFINITION OF THE "EMPLOYEES" on Page 2 of said Group Policy, as amended, the following:

Group Policy No. 6683-GLR bearing date of July 1, 1933
and insuring the Employees of

RAVENHOLM-DAFFERTY, INC.
(Herein called the Employer)

is hereby amended as follows:

Effective June 13, 1944 by adding to Section 8 on Page 1
thereof, the following:

"It is understood and agreed that the financial
experience under this Policy shall be combined with the
financial experience under Group Policies No. 4577-GLR, No. 668-GLR,
and No. 5677-GLR, issued to the Employer with dates of issue May 19, 1940,
October 11, 1940 and August 4, 1941, respectively,
for the purpose of determining any divisible surplus hereunder
and under said Group Policies."

The foregoing amendment is to be attached to and made part of said Group
Policy, and is subject to the agreements and covenants therein contained.
