Re: Johns-Manville Asbestosis Cases.

Gentlemen:-

As an inducement to Johns-Manville Corporation to settle on the terms mentioned in letter of even date herewith, the 11 cases named therein against said corporation, now pending in the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey, wherein I am the attorney for the plaintiffs, I hereby state and agree as follows:

1. I do not now represent any person or persons other than said plaintiffs in any pending or proposed claim or claims or action or actions against said corporation to recover damages by reason of conditions alleged to exist or to have existed at any factory or plant of said corporation, or of any of its predecessors in interest or of any of its controlled or subsidiary companies.

2. I do not know of any claims or actions against said corporation or against any of its controlled or subsidiary companies arising out of said alleged conditions other than those of said plaintiffs.

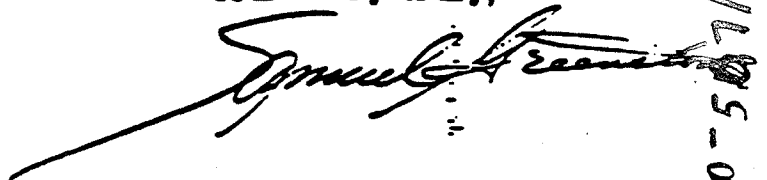
3. I will not accept any retainer to represent or to assist any claimant or plaintiff as attorney or counsel or otherwise in any claim or action for the recovery of damages arising out of said alleged conditions.

4. I will not, directly or indirectly, assist any other attorney or person in presenting any such claim or in investigating same, or in starting or trying any such action.

5. I will not disclose the terms of the settlement to any person except to each of the plaintiffs in the particular case in which he or she is plaintiff, until settlement is finally consummated on July 31, 1934.
