SUBJECT U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) - Utility Response to Consideration of Ban on A/C Pipe

Enclosed is a letter from the City of Port Arthur (Texas) expressing opposition to EPA's consideration to ban the use of A/C pipe. To the best of Staff's knowledge, this submittal was not made at the prompting of industry representatives. The letter obviously raises the question of whether AACPP should attempt to coordinate a "grass roots" campaign to generate support from other A/C pipe users. This possibility was raised with Kickland & Ellis in late 1983 and will be considered in the context of industry's overall strategy for the EPA rulemaking.
